GUIDELINES FOR DISPLAYING ART at PAPA GALLERY (last revision 2021)

- 1. All art displayed must be original. Original art is art produced from the artist's own hand; not reproduced from any published painting or photograph or copied from a source other than what the artist has a legal right to.
- 2. Every painting must be signed.
- 3. A 35% donation will be retained by the Gallery when a painting sells.
- 4. The PAPA Gallery retains the right to refuse any art brought in for display.
- 5. Once a painting is hanging in the Gallery, prices are non-negotiable.
- 6. Art may not be removed from display (except by sale, or special permission) during the show period it has been entered in.
- 7. Reproductions of your paintings (prints) are allowed for Unframed pieces and Card packs only. All other show entries must be originals.
- 8. Framed Art may be for sale or "Display Only". All other entries must be for sale.
- 9. Paintings (if unsold) cannot be re-entered in a PAPA show until two show cycles (6 months) have completed.
- 10. Exhibiting artists may enter works to display and/sell at the time of the next Show Change. Shows change on the last Tuesday of January, April, July, and October.
- 11. Exhibiting artists participating in a show must sign up to work as Docent for 3 days during the show period. (Training will be provided)

The PAPA Monthly Newsletter, "Dutch's Doodle" will remind you when it's time for a Show Change, and announce any changes, or updates that apply.
